**Friday 5th November**—Last day for online Scholastic Book Club orders.

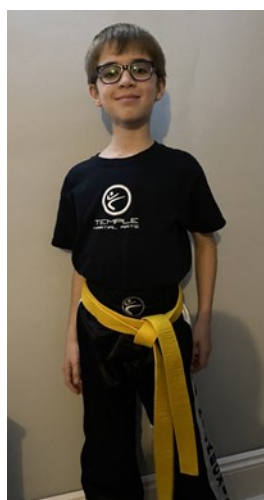


Teresa, our catering supervisor sadly says goodbye to us all today after 9 years of cooking and serving dinners to Highfields' children and staff.
